ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 74927 in Application No. 50279, and by Decisions Nos. 76668 and 78412 in Application No. 51212, Golden Pacific Airlines, Inc. was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger air carrier between Concord and San Francisco, Sacramento and Tahoe Valley Airport, and San Francisco and Tahoe Valley Airport, respectively.

On or about November, 1971, Golden Pacific discontinued all service to and from Tahoe Valley Airport. It has also come to this Commission's attention that the carrier's service to Concord has been minimal with frequent cancellations resulting in considerably less than the minimum number of flights as required in Golden Pacific Airlines' certificate. The Commission finds that the continuous discontinuance of service at Tahoe Valley Airport and reduced service to Concord by the carrier is good cause for revocation of authority to serve these points.

The Commission concludes that Tahoe Valley Airport and Concord should be deleted as points named in the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued to Golden Pacific Airlines, Inc.

IT IS ORDERED that the authority to operate as a passenger air carrier between Concord and San Francisco, Sacramento and Tahoe Valley Airport, and San Francisco and Tahoe Valley Airport is revoked. The certificate of Golden Pacific Airlines, Inc., as revised by this order, will be set forth by further order of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this order to Mr. Robert Darwin, President, Golden Pacific Airlines, Inc., at San Francisco International Airport, San Francisco, California 94128, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 30th day after the above mailing to Golden Pacific, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
