SUPPLEMENTAL INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 80021, dated May 2, 1972, Jowaltken, Inc. was granted interim authority to assess a rate less than the minimum rate for the transportation of processed silica sand from the Mission Viejo plant of Owens-Illinois Glass Company in San Juan Capistrano to Huntington Park for Latchford Glass Company. The authority is scheduled to expire November 2, 1972.

We are informed that the Mission Viejo plant is not in full production. It appears and the Commission finds that the temporary authority should be extended to March 1, 1973.

IT IS ORDERED that the authority granted by Decision No. 80021 in this proceeding is further extended to expire with March 1, 1973.

The effective date of this order shall be September 1, 1972.
