SUPPLEMENTAL INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 80020, dated May 2, 1972, Jowaltken, Inc. was granted interim authority to assess a rate less than the minimum rate for the transportation of processed silica sand from the Mission Viejo plant of Owens-Illinois Glass Company in San Juan Capistrano to Vernon for Glass Container Corporation. The authority was granted pending public hearing after operations commenced. The interim authority is scheduled to expire November 2, 1972.

We are informed that the Mission Viejo plant still is not in full production. It appears, and the Commission finds, that the temporary authority should be further extended to March 1, 1973.

IT IS ORDERED that the authority granted by Decision No. 80020 in this proceeding is further extended to expire with March 1, 1973.

The effective date of this order shall be September 1, 1972.
