ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

Kenneth Henricksen requests authority to suspend passenger stage service between the City of San Rafael on the one hand, and Mare Island Naval Shipyard on the other until September 1, 1973.

The authority was granted by Decision No. 78042, dated December 8, 1970 and amended by Decision No. 78616, dated April 27, 1971, in the above-numbered application. The service has been operating since that time; however, it is stated by applicant that, at present, there is insufficient passenger traffic potential to generate the amount of revenue required to cover the costs of operation. Applicant is of the opinion that the authorized operation may become economically feasible within a year's time.

After consideration, the Commission finds that the granting of the suspension would not be adverse to the public interest.

IT IS ORDERED that:





1. The operating authority between the City of San Rafael and Mare Island Naval Shipyard granted by Decision No. 78042 and amended by Decision No. 78616 is hereby suspended until September 1, 1973, unless terminated before then by further Commission order.

2. After the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Kenneth Henricksen shall amend his tariffs and timetables presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

Should Kenneth Hendricksen not reinstitute service on or before September 1, 1973, certificate authority for the San Rafael operation is hereby revoked and all applicable timetable and tariff filings shall be amended by Kenneth Hendricksen on not less than five-days' notice to the public and this Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be ten days after the date hereof.
