ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By petition filed July 14, 1972, various highway carriers, shippers, and other parties sought suspension and investigation of certain reduced railroad rates on designated iron and steel articles published in Supplement 36 to Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent, Freight Tariff 272-B. The specific commodity descriptions and rates involved are contained in Items 8500, 8600, 8625 and 8650, Section 4-A of the tariff. Supplement 36 was filed with an issued date of June 22, 1972, and an effective date of July 26, 1972. The Commission did not suspend the reduced rates. Accordingly, the subject rates went into effect on the published effective date, pursuant to Section 455 of the Public Utilities Code. Under the circumstances I & S Case No. 9402 has become moot.
