ORDER The Western Pacific Railroad Company is hereby authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Dobbin Drive in the City of San Jose in the County of Santa Clara at the location and substantially as shown by plans attached to the application to be identified as Crossing No. 4G-16.94-C. Construction of the rail crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order 72-A with tops of rails flush with finished roadway. Width of crossing construction measured at right angles to the street shall be not less than 40 feet. Finished grades of approach shall be as shown on the plans attached to the application. Clearances, including any curbs, shall conform to General Order 26-D. Walkways shall conform to General Order 118 in that the transition slope between walkways required under General Order 118 and top of roadway shall provide a reasonable regular surface with gradual slope not to exceed one inch vertical to eight inches horizontal in all directions of approach. Protection, governed by General Order 75-B, at the crossing shall be two Standard No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflexreflective sheet material. Construction expense of the crossing shall be borne by the applicant. Maintenance cost of the crossing within lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by the applicant.
