ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Ordering paragraph 3 of Decision No. 79143, dated September 8, 1971, in this proceeding, granted applicant a one-year period to commence operations under the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 73811, dated March 5, 1968, in Application No. 49712, authorizing scheduled common carrier passenger service by vessel between San Francisco and Sausalito subject to the condition that if service were not commenced within said one-year period said authority should lapse and terminate unless the one-year period were extended by further order of the Commission. The one-year period will expire on September 28, 1972.

Ey the Petition for Extension of Time filed September 7, 1972, applicant requests that the one-year period within which to commence operations in said ordering paragraph 3 be modified to provide for a two-year period. In support of said request, the application alleges that applicant has been unsuccessful in its efforts to obtain a landing site from the City of Sausalito; that a complaint was filed against said City in the Marin County Superior Court on July 7, 1971, seeking to compel it to make available suitable landing facilities; that said complaint is now being litigated; and that as soon as applicant obtains a landing site in Sausalito, it will commence the scheduled operations in issue.

The Commission finds that the sought extension is justified and concludes that the application should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Applicant is hereby granted an extension of time to September 28, 1973 within which to commence the common carrier passenger service by vessel between San Francisco and Sausalito referred to in ordering paragraph 3 of Decision No. 79143, dated September 8, 1971, in this proceeding.

2. In all other respects said Decision No. 79143 shall remain in full force and effect.
