ORDER GRANTING PETITIONS TO INTERVENE

The above-entitled proceeding involves the application of Pacific Southwest Airlines to purchase the controlling interest in Air California.

Petitions to intervene have been filed by three competitor air carriers; Western Airlines, Hughes Air West and Holiday Resources, formerly known as Holiday Airlines.

In addition, three employee organizations also have requested intervenor status: Southwest Independent Stewardesses Association; Transport Workers Union of America, AFL-CIO, and Air Transport Division, Local 505, Transport Workers of America (TWU); and Airline, Aerospace & Allied Employees, Local Union No. 2707, International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Chauffeurs, Warehousemen & Helpers of America (Teamsters).

Finally, the following public entities have petitioned to intervene: County of Orange, County of Sacramento, City of Oakland, and City of Newport Beach. ✓

All of these petitions allege that the proposed consolidation may have adverse effects upon them and that they wish to participate in order to protect their interests. No objection has been made to any of the petitions.
