ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Decision No. 79939, dated April 11, 1972, in this proceeding, F. O. Culy, Sr., Harold F. Culy and Frank O. Culy, Jr., doing business as Riteway Transportation, were authorized on an interim basis, pending public hearing, to assess rates less than the minimum rates on certain transportation for Campbell Soup Company.

Applicants have informed the Commission that they are no longer performing this transportation, and request that the application be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 79939 is rescinded and Application No. 53135 is dismissed.
