SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Following the issuance of Decision No. 80340, dated August 1, 1972, under the above-entitled application, it has been determined that while the rates proposed by Southwest for the Northstar development were found to be reasonable, no order authorizing them to be placed into effect has been issued; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Southwest Gas Corporation is authorized to file with this Commission tariff schedules applicable for service to the Northstar development as set forth in Exhibit I of Application No. 53033, plus any applicable tracking increases which have occurred since the filing of said application. The effective date of any such tariff schedules to be on or after October 8, 1972.

2. In all other respects, Decision No. 80340 shall stand as issued.
