ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 72973 in Application No. 49378, and Decision No. 78432 in Application No. 52317, South Coast Transit Corp. was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Santa Ana, Huntington Beach, Newport Beach, Laguna Beach and intermediate points.

By a letter dated August 29, 1972, applicant's attorney stated that the Orange County Transit District has entered into an agreement with South Coast Transit Corporation whereby the District is purchasing the existing system of South Coast Transit Corporation. Pursuant to Section 40224 of the Public Utilities Code authorization for such transfer of operations is not required. South Coast Transit Corporation discontinued its passenger stage service on August 31, 1972 in accordance with the agreement.

It appears and the Commission finds that this constitutes good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Santa Ana, Huntington Beach, Newport Beach, Laguna Beach and intermediate points, authorized by Decisions Nos. 72973 and 78432 in Applications Nos. 49378 and 52317, respectively, is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission

in the name of South Coast Transit Corporation are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after the above mailing, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
