ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 80413, dated August 29, 1972, United States Cold Storage of California was authorized to discontinue operations as a public utility warehouseman at Petaluma. To accommodate an orderly withdrawal of merchandise from its Petaluma warehouse, applicant requests that the time to comply with the tariff provisions of ordering paragraph 2 be extended to December 31, 1972.
