ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 77016 dated March 31, 1970, in Appli-
 cation No. 51279, Kenneth B. Jackson, dba Bay View Charter, was
 granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate
 as a passenger stage corporation between United Air Lines Mainte-
 nance Base, near San Francisco International Airport, on the one
 hand, and the Cities of Fairfield, Vallejo, Crockett, Pinole,
 San Pablo, Richmond, El Cerrito, Berkeley, Emeryville, Concord,
 Pleasant Hill, Walnut Creek and Oakland, on the other hand.

Kenneth B. Jackson has not filed acceptance of the certi-
 ficate granted him and has not filed tariffs and timetables with
 the Commission as required by Decision No. 77016. Since May 10,
 1970, Kenneth B. Jackson has had no evidence on file with this
 Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed
 by law for payment of damage, for personal injury or property
 damage as required by General Order No. 101-C.

By Decision No. 78140 dated January 5, 1971, in Appli-
 cation No. 51279, the certificate of Kenneth B. Jackson to operate
 as a passenger stage corporation was revoked. Because a written
 response indicating a potential transfer of operative rights was
 received before the effective date, the revocation was stayed
 until further order of the Commission. On September 30, 1971, the

Commission was informed that the attempt to transfer authority was unsuccessful. Since no application for transfer has been received, the Commission concludes that Kenneth B. Jackson's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation should be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 78140, dated January 5, 1971, is affirmed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
