ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decisions Nos. 31664, 33402, and 33721 dated January 16, 1939, August 13, 1940, and December 10, 1940, respectively, in Applications Nos. 22179 and 23526, Loren W. Smith, doing business as Pomona, Chino, Ontario Bus Line, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Pomona, Ontario, Upland, Chino, Norco and Corona.

The Pomona, Chino, Ontario Bus Line has no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-C. It is understood that in 1966 the Pomona Valley Municipal Transit District System took over the operations of Loren W. Smith who had ceased operating at that time.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized

by Decisions Nos. 31664, 33402, and 33721 in Application Nos. 22179 and 23526 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Pomona, Chino, Ontario Bus Line are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this order to Loren W. Smith at 680 East 5th Street, Ontario, California, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 30th day after the mailing to Loren W. Smith, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
