O P I N I O N

J. C. Hornall requests authority to discontinue operations as a public utility warehouseman at College City, Colusa County.

The operative authority is prescriptive in nature and was set forth in Commission order dated August 16, 1960, in Case No. 6836.

It is alleged that applicant is 82 years of age and is partially paralyzed from a stroke; that the property was sold on June 16, 1971, for a cash consideration of \$20,000; and that the new owner is presently using the property as a private warehouse.

After consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's service as a public utility warehouseman. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. J. C. Hornall may discontinue operations as a public utility warehouseman at College City, Colusa County.
2. The prescriptive authority set forth in Commission order dated August 16, 1960, in Case No. 6836, is hereby amended by revised Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

3. J. C. Hornall shall amend or reissue the tariff on file with the Commission to reflect the authority granted by paragraph 1. The tariff filing shall be made effective not earlier than ten days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

AMENDED APPENDIX A TO ORDER INSTITUTING INVESTIGATION  
AND DETERMINING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHTS IN CASE NO. 6836

J. C. Hornall possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space as follows:

<u>Location</u>	<u>Number of Square Feet of Floor Space</u>
Arbuckle (Colusa County)	16,000

(The floor space shown above is exclusive of the 50,000 square feet of expansion permissible under Section 1051 of the Public Utilities Code.)
