ORDER EXTENDING PERIODS OF SUSPENSION

Ordering paragraph 2 in the Order of Suspension and Investigation in Case No. 9396 provides that the operation and effectiveness of the tariffs filed by The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company under Advice Letter No. 10834 are suspended to and including October 28, 1972, unless otherwise ordered.

Ordering paragraph 2 in the Order of Suspension in Case No. 9397 similarly provides that the operation and effectiveness of the tariffs filed by General Telephone Company of California under Advice Letter No. 2765 are suspended to and including October 28, 1972, unless otherwise ordered.

A public hearing having been set in Cases Nos. 9396 and 9397 for November 10, 1972, it appears that a Commission decision in these proceedings cannot become effective prior to October 28, 1972, and that the period of suspension of the effective date of the tariffs should be extended; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the suspensions of the effective date of the tariffs filed by Advice Letter No. 10834 of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company and by Advice Letter No. 2765 of General Telephone Company of California be, and they hereby are, extended for further periods of six months beyond October 28, 1972, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.
