<u>o p i n i o n</u>

By Decision No. 79701, dated February 8, 1972, Central Coast Truck Service, Inc., a corporation, was authorized to depart from the minimum rates named in Minimum Rate Tariff 8 for the transportation of fresh carrots in bulk in collapsible bins on pallets for Safeway Stores, Incorporated, from various points in California to Richmond and Sacramento and to return without charge the empty bins and pallets to point of original shipment or such other point or points equidistant or less from point of original destination and intermediate thereto. This authority was granted on a temporary basis pending a hearing and was scheduled to expire August 8, 1972. The authority was extended to November 8, 1972 by Decision No. 80341, dated August 1, 1972.

Public hearing on the application was held August 28, 1972, at San Francisco, before Examiner Turpen.

The testimony received at the public hearing confirmed the data set forth in the application and in Decision No. 79701. As the authorized rates are subject to any surcharges set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff 8, such surcharges offset labor cost increases incurred by applicant on July 1, 1972. -1A. 53114 JM

After public hearing, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the sought rate deviation is reasonable. The Commission concludes that the sought authority should be extended for a full year.

<u>order</u>

IT IS ORDERED that the authority granted to Central Coast Truck Service, Inc., by Decision No. 79701, and extended by Decision No. 80341, in this proceeding, is further extended to November 8, 1973.
