SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 80173, dated June 20, 1972, the Commission ordered Southern California Water Company to offer the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners of America, Local 586, Housing Sponsorship Corporation, the option of one of two alternate methods of metering domestic and private fire protection in serving a multi-unit housing development:

- a. A 4-inch domestic metered service and two separate 8-inch private fire protection services, pursuant to defendant's tariffs, or
- b. An agreement providing for combined domestic and private fire protection service through two 8-inch metered services whose meters are designed for the low losses and high flows required for fire flows.

Complainant accepted option (b) and signed the necessary contract, dated July 10, 1972, a copy of which was submitted for the record herein. Defendant then refunded the difference between the cost of two 8-inch combined services and the estimated cost of one

4-inch domestic service. The Southern California Water Company having complied with the orders of Decision No. 80173, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that this Case 9247 be terminated and the effective date of this order is the date hereof.
