ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 79976 dated April 25, 1972, Cal-Autofone was authorized to purchase on or before September 1, 1972, a radiotelephone service from Ukiah Answering Service. Cal-Autofone was unable to complete the purchase by September 1, 1972 and, through inadvertence, failed to request an extension of time. Cal-Autofone now requests an extension of time to complete the purchase which in all other respects is final.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the time limit for compliance with Decision No. 79976 is extended to November 1, 1972.

In all other respects Decision No. 79976 shall remain in full force and effect.
