O P I N I O N A N D O R D E R

By Decision No. 76817 dated February 20, 1970, in Application No. 51238, Anaheim Jitney Systems was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code between points in the City of Anaheim, Knott's Berry Farm, Movieland Wax Museum, and intermediate points.

It appears that since December 8, 1970, Anaheim Jitney Systems has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-C. The carrier has abandoned service and ceased operations.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized by Decision No. 76817 in Application No. 51238 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Anaheim Jitney Systems are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be the 30th day after the above mailing to Anaheim Jitney Systems unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
