O P I N I O N

By this application, Bellair Expediting Service, Inc., an Illinois corporation qualified to do business in California, requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to Section 1010 of the Public Utilities Code to conduct business as a freight forwarder of general commodities between the points set forth in Exhibit 3-B attached to the second amendment to the application providing transportation by aircraft originates or terminates at one of the following airports:

Bakersfield-Kern County Airport
Fresno Air Terminal
Lockheed Air Terminal, Inc., Burbank
Long Beach Airport
Los Angeles International Airport
Oakland International Airport
Sacramento Metropolitan Airport
San Diego International Airport
San Francisco International Airport
San Jose Municipal Airport

Applicant is presently engaged in business as a domestic air freight forwarder under Civil Aeronautics Board Operating Authority No. 319.

In providing service as a freight forwarder, applicant will pick up, or cause to be picked up, commodities from shippers located throughout the State of California. After consolidation, applicant will transport or arrange for transportation of such consolidated shipments by motor vehicle to airports in the State of California, where the property will be transported by air carrier to other California airports, where the property, in turn, will be picked up by motor vehicle and, after segregation, delivered to the consignee. In the conduct of the proposed operations, applicant would utilize highway common carriers, air carriers, and passenger stage corporations, as may be appropriate. Applicant, in performing the proposed service, would assume responsibility for the through transportation of the property from origin to destination, pursuant to tariff rates, rules and charges filed with this Commission.

Applicant's proposed service would be performed on an "on call" basis as limited or restricted by the operating schedules of carriers operating under authorization of the Civil Aeronautics Board or the Public Utilities Commission.

Applicant also requests authority to utilize the services of highway common carriers or passenger stage corporations as the underlying carrier, in emergencies only, to provide the transportation between airports which would ordinarily be provided by an air carrier in the event air carriage is not possible because of weather conditions or some other circumstance beyond applicant's control.

Applicant proposes rates, rules, and regulations which are generally competitive with Emery Air Freight Corporation, on file with the Commission as Air Freight Tariff No. 2, Cal. PUC No. 2.

Applicant alleges that public convenience and necessity require that it be granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide service as a freight forwarder between points and places in the State of California, for the following reasons: The movement of air freight cargo by applicant on an intrastate basis is required in order for applicant adequately to serve its customers

who ship interstate and to provide this service for its shippers within the State of California. Granting the authority will enable applicant to serve its shipping public more efficiently by providing a complete specialized door to door service for air freight shipments with detailed relaying of information, and permit simplified accounting for its shippers.

In support of the application, applicant filed two verified statements from persons whose firms would utilize applicant's service if the application is granted. Said verified statements are hereby received in evidence as Exhibit 1.

Exhibit 5 attached to the application contains a copy of applicant's balance sheet as of June 30, 1971; it discloses assets totaling \$182,429 offset by liabilities totaling \$90,297. Exhibit 6 attached to the application is a copy of applicant's profit and loss statement for the year ended June 30, 1971; it discloses a profit after income taxes of \$42,717.

No protests to the granting of the application have been received.

After consideration the Commission finds that:

1. Applicant possesses the experience and financial resources to institute and maintain the service herein authorized.
2. Public convenience and necessity require that the proposed service be authorized.
3. A public hearing is not necessary.

The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order.

Bellair Expediting Service, Inc., is hereby placed on notice that operative rights, as such, do not constitute a class of property which may be capitalized or used as an element of value in rate fixing for any amount of money in excess of that originally paid to the State as the consideration for the grant of such rights. Aside from their purely permissive aspect, these rights extend to the

holder a full or partial monopoly of a class of business. This monopoly feature may be modified or canceled at any time by the State, which is not in any respect limited as to the number of rights which may be given.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to Bellair Expediting Service, Inc., a corporation, authorizing it to operate as a freight forwarder, as defined in Section 220 of the Public Utilities Code, between the points and subject to the conditions set forth in Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations. Failure so to do may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.

- a. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. Applicant is placed on notice that, if it accepts the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, it will be required, among other things, to file annual reports of its operations.
- b. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file tariffs, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.
- c. The tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than thirty days after the effective date of this order on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the service herein authorized.

- d. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 117.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

BELLAIR EXPEDITING SERVICE, INC., by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to operate as a freight forwarder as defined in Section 220 of the Public Utilities Code for the transportation of general commodities via the lines of air common carriers, highway common carriers and passenger stage corporations, between the California points listed in Appendix B attached hereto, subject to the following conditions:

1. Applicant shall not ship nor arrange to ship any property unless such property shall have transportation by aircraft originate or terminate at one of the following airports:

2. In emergencies only, such as an airport being closed because of inclement weather, highway common carriers or passenger stage corporations may be used as underlying carriers to provide transportation between the airports specified in Paragraph 1 hereof.
3. Except as provided in Paragraph 2, the authority to ship via the lines of highway common carriers or passenger stage corporations is limited to service in the pickup and delivery terminal areas of airport cities of origin or destination as named in Paragraph 1 and as specifically described in Appendix B hereof.
4. Bellair Expediting Service, Inc. shall establish door-to-door rates for service between airports including points within the pickup and delivery terminal areas of airport cities of origin and destination as described in Paragraphs 1 and 3 above and Appendix B hereof.
