ORDER DENYING TEMPORARY
RESTRAINING ORDER

Complainant alleges that defendant is commencing an expansion of its operations as a radiotelephone utility into the Pomona-Ontario-Corona area presently served by complainant. Complainant asks that the status quo be preserved by issuance of a temporary restraining order prohibiting defendant from establishing message centers in the area in question.

The Commission is of the opinion that insufficient grounds have been asserted to show irreparable injury to complainant which can only be abated by the granting of extraordinary relief based solely on complainant's present pleadings.

The request for a temporary restraining order is denied and the complaint will be processed in the normal manner. The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
