SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The City of Hayward is hereby authorized to install Standard No. 1 (General Order No. 75-B) crossing signs reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material for an interim period as a substitution for protection of two Standard 3 flashing light crossing signals supplemented with additional flashing light signals on cantilever arms as ordered by Decision No. 80176. The interim period is to expire January 31, 1973.

In all other respects, Decision No. 80176 is to remain in effect.

The purpose of this temporary authorization is to facilitate the construction and development of the industrial tract. The Western Pacific Railroad Company does not have material or men available at this time to install the flashing light signals.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
