ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

By Decision No. 79482, dated December 14, 1971 in the above entitled matter, the Commission granted temporary authority to Valley Airlines, Inc. (Valley) to conduct nonstop service between Oakland-Fresno, Oakland-Bakersfield, and Oakland-Santa Barbara until November 30, 1972. Valley was further directed to submit evidence by September 30, 1972 to demonstrate that it has the aircraft and resources necessary to conduct these nonstop operations permanently.

Valley requests an extension of time until June 30, 1973 for submission of such evidence. Valley states that because it presently has Application No. 53382 pending before the Commission, it is not able to evaluate its aircraft and resources requirements without a great deal of conjecture.

Valley's request is reasonable and will be granted.
