ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 80260, dated July 18, 1972, in this proceeding, ordered R.T.I., Inc., to pay a fine of \$1,938.28 on or before September 18, 1972. \$500 has been paid on the fine. By letter filed October 30, 1972, R.T.I., Inc., has informed the Commission that it has been unable to collect the \$1,438.28 in undercharges ordered to be collected by the decision and that it has now retained counsel to assist in the collection. It requests that it be authorized to pay the balance of the fine in weekly installments of \$500.

Upon consideration, the request will be granted as provided in the order which follows.

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IT IS ORDERED that the balance of \$1,438.28 remaining to be paid on the fine imposed on R.T.I., Inc., a California corporation, by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 80260 may be paid in two installments of \$500 each and a third installment for the balance, with the first installment due thirty days after the effective date hereof and the remaining installments due each week thereafter.
