OBINION

Petitioners Foremost Foods Company, a division of Foremost-McKesson, Inc., and Challenge Foods Co. seek certain changes in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (MRT 2). Specifically, petitioners seek to amend Items 40, 41 and 42 of MRT 2 by revising Note 2 as follows:

NOTE 2:

- (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), exemption applies only in connection with straight or mixed shipments of commodities making reference hereto and only when shipped in quantities of not less than 20,000 pounds.
- (b) The provisions of paragraph (a) of this note do not apply in connection with:

(1) The transportation of Eggs moving in straight shipments from point of production.

(2) Shipments moving in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles or in milk shipping cans from point of production.

Presently Note 2 provides: "Exemption applies only when commodities flagged subject to this note are shipped in milk shipping cans, in bottles in cases or crates, or in bulk in tanks." Petitioners also

seek to make cottage cheese; eggs, other than shelled, desiccated or frozen; ice cream mix, unflavored, and pot cheese subject to petitioners' proposed revision of Note 2. Said commodities are not now subject to Note 2.

Petitioners also seek to amend Item 335.5 of MRT 2 by changing the title of said item from "Dairy and Related Product, viz." to "BUTTER, CHEESE, MARGARINE, EDIBLE OIL PRODUCTS AND RELATED ARTICLES, viz.:" adding the following note to be applicable to cheese and cheese foods (55470):

Note 1: Provisions making reference hereto are not applicable in connection with shipments of the following:

Cheese, viz.: Bakers curd or cottage cheese, with or without flavoring, fruit or vegetables, creamed or other than creamed.

Petitioners further seek to establish a new tariff item (Item 335) covering shipments of specific dairy products and related articles in mixed shipments.

Petitioners allege that following many months of negotiation among producers and shippers of dairy products and other commodities, and the carriers who serve them, the sought proposal was agreed upon for establishing and modifying rates, rules and regulations for the transportation of specified dairy products and mixed shipments thereof with other commodities. Petitioners further allege that because of the confusion and uncertainty resulting from the application of the rates and rules now provided for the transportation of dairy products and particularly mixed shipments thereof with other commodities, and, further, because of the excessive documentation required with respect to mixed shipments and, further, because of the unsuitability of the rates and rules to those shipments, the shippers and carriers of these products have joined together to develop a workable, satisfactory and compensatory proposal.

Petitioners aver that the establishment of new Item 335 will be complementary to the present Item 335.5. This means that

the rate levels for the various dairy products involved and mixed shipments including dairy products will be consistent.

Petitioners aver that unless immediate relief is granted they will be forced, through economic necessity, to resort to proprietary carriage, in which event the subject traffic will be lost to common carriers for the foreseeable future.

California Trucking Association, California Manufacturers Association and Traffic Managers Conference of California filed protests to the petition; however, such protests were withdrawn subsequent to the filing of the second amendment to the petition.

After consideration the Commission finds that:

- 1. There is a need for the transportation of dairy products which are presently subject to rates in MRT 2 in mixed shipments with dairy products which presently are exempt from the provisions of MRT 2.
- 2. Item 90 of MRT 2 prohibits the transportation of mixed shipments described in Finding 1.
- 3. Should the prohibition not be modified it is possible that certain traffic of dairy products presently enjoyed by for-hire carriers may be diverted to proprietary carriage.
- 4. The proposed modification of MRT 2 will permit the transportation of mixed shipments of dairy products and related products presently prohibited by Item 90 of MRT 2.
 - 5. A public hearing is not necessary.
- 6. The Commission has previously concluded that findings pursuant to Rule 23.1 of the Commission's Rules of Procedure entitled "Compliance with the Economic Stabilization Act of 1970" are inappropriate and unnecessary in connection with classification changes such as are involved in this proceeding.

Based on the above findings the Commission concludes that the petition should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective January 13, 1973, the revised pages contained in Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 2. Tariff publications resulting in increases authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public; such authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within sixty days after the effective date of this order; and tariff publications resulting in reductions may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.
- 3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
- 4. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decision No. 31606, as

amended, are hereby authorized to establish in their teriffs the increases necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.

- 5. Common carriers maintaining rates on the same level as Minimum Rate Tariff 2 rates for the transportation of commodities and/or for transportation not subject to Minimum Rate Tariff 2 are authorized to increase said rates by the same amounts authorized for Minimum Rate Tariff 2 rates herein.
- 6. Common carriers maintaining rates at levels other than the minimum rates for the transportation of commodities and/or for transportation not subject to Minimum Rate Tariff 2 are authorized to increase said rates by the same amounts authorized for Minimum Rate Tariff 2 rates herein.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty-four days after the date hereof.
