SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Karlson Bros. Trucking Service, a corporation, is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission. By the Certificate of Amendment of the Articles of Incorporation duly filed with the Secretary of the State of California on September 26, 1972, Karlson Bros. Trucking Service changed its corporate name to Rogers Motor Express. A request for a change of corporate name having been received from Karlson Bros. Trucking Service, its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name and it will be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by Decision No. 59826, in Application No. 41314, as amended, is further amended by substituting the name "Rogers Motor Express" in the place and stead of "Karlson Bros. Trucking Service".

2. Within one hundred and twenty days after the date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Rogers Motor Express shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule No. 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
