## Decision No. 80816

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BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the City of El Monte for an order authorizing construction of a separation structure under the mainline track of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company for Durfee Avenue in the City of El Monte, California.

Application No. 53179 (Filed February 16, 1972)

## <u>ORDER</u>

The City of El Monte is hereby authorized to construct Durfee Avenue at separated grades under the tracks of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company in the City of El Monte, Los Angeles County, at the location described and in the manner as shown in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-496.4-B.

The priority list of grade separation projects for the year 1972, as set forth in Decision No. 80079, shows this project as Priority No. 50.

Clearances shall be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D. Walkways along any new or reconstructed trackage, either temporary or permanent, shall conform to General Order No. 118. Walkway areas adjacent to any trackage subject to rail operations shall be maintained free of obstructions and shall promptly be restored to their original condition in the event of damage during construction. Walkways adjacent to any trackage which may have been temporarily removed from service shall be restored to their original condition prior to resumption of rail operations.

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the City of El Monte and the Southern Pacific Transportation Company and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the railroad, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs by further order.

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Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This cuthorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
