Additional undercharges were found in connection with two other shippers, and respondent carrier was fined $\$ 5,509.91$. Conrotto has informed the Comission that the undercharges in connection $\because$ with the transportation performed for Iucky Strike should be reduced by $\$ 21.49$ to $\$ 398.61$. We agree. 1. Decision No. 80570 dated Octobex 3, 1972 is mended as folicw:
2. Tine amount of the undezcharges in connection with Liciky Strike Brokerage Co. and the total amount of the undercharges shown in Finding 5 are reduced to $\$ 398.61$ and $\$ 2,483.42$, zespectively.
3. The amount of ifne pursuant to Section $2: 00$ of the Public Utilities Code shown in Conclusion 2 is reduced to $\$ 2,488.42$.
4. The amount of fine Nike Conroteo Truciking is cirectec to pay by ordering paragraph 1 is reduced to \$5,438.42 and the time iimit within which to pay said fine is extended to December 20, 1972.

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2. In all other respects, Decision No. 80570 shail remain in full force and effect.
