ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 80570

Decision No. 80570 dated October 3, 1972, in this proceeding, found that Mike Conrotto Trucking had undercharged \$420.10 in connection with transportation performed for Lucky Strike Brokerage Co. Additional undercharges were found in connection with two other shippers, and respondent carrier was fined \$5,509.91. Conrotto has informed the Commission that the undercharges in connection " with the transportation performed for Lucky Strike should be reduced by \$21.49 to \$398.61. We agree. In the circumstances,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 80570 dated October 3, 1972 is amended as follows:

1. The amount of the undercharges in connection with Lucky Strike Brokerage Co. and the total amount of the undercharges shown in Finding 5 are reduced to \$398.61 and \$2,488.42, respectively.

2. The amount of fine pursuant to Section 2100 of the Public Utilities Code shown in Conclusion 2 is reduced to \$2,488.42.

3. The amount of fine Mike Conrotto Trucking is directed to pay by ordering paragraph 1 is reduced to \$5,488.42 and the time limit within which to pay said fine is extended to December 20, 1972.

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2. In all other respects, Decision No. 80570 shall remain in full force and effect.
