ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 75419 dated March 11, 1969, in Application No. 50810, Watts Labor Community Action Committee was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code between points within the Avalon-South Central Los Angeles area and various industrial areas or locations as described.

It appears that since June 11, 1971, Watts Labor Community Action Committee has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-C. The carrier has abandoned service and ceased operations.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized by Decision No. 75419 in Application No. 50810 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Watts Labor Community Action Committee are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this order to Ted Watkins, Chairman, at 11401 South Central Avenue, Los Angeles, California 90059, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 30th day after the above mailing to Watts Labor Community Action Committee unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
