ORDER DENYING CEASE AND DESIST.

In a verified complaint filed November 29, 1972, complainant has included within his prayer for relief a request for a cease and desist order to defendant "...ordering it to withdraw its application 2617-C2-P-73 before the Federal Communications Commission." Complainant contends that defendant is in the process of expanding its service into the service area of complainant.

The Commission is of the opinion that the factual basis for the complaint herein is not sufficiently clear to warrant issuance of a cease and desist order based solely on the pleadings. Therefore, the request for an immediate cease and desist order will be denied, and the complaint will be processed in the normal manner.
