ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Commission on November 30, 1972 received a written request by letter dated November 29, 1972 from Francis H. Ferraro, Exhibit No. 12 herein, for a further extension of time of one year of the final date of December 11, 1972 by which compliance with ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 73361, issued herein on November 21, 1967, may be completed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the first line of paragraph 1 of the order in Decision No. 73361, issued herein on November 21, 1967, is further revised to read:

"1. On or before December 11, 1973, ..."
