ORDER

Pursuant to Section 854 of the California Public Utilities Code, Franklin J. Flynn proposes to acquire control of Crystal Falls Water Company, a California corporation providing public utility water service in a portion of Tuolumne County. Franklin J. Flynn has agreed to purchase all of the water company's outstanding capital stock for the sum of \$300,000.

After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed acquisition of control of Crystal Falls Water Company by Franklin J. Flynn would not be adverse to the public interest and concludes that it should be authorized. A public hearing is not necessary. The action taken herein shall not be construed as a finding of the value of any stock of Crystal Falls Water Company.
