ORDER EXTENDING VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION

The operating authority of Gene W. East, an individual, doing business as Gene W. East Vacuum Truck Service, because of illness of the owner, was suspended by Decision No. 79549, dated January 4, 1972, in Application No. 35736, from the date of the decision to December 6, 1972.

A written request has been received to extend the voluntary suspension for another year because of the continued illness of the owner.

The Commission finds that the proposed extension of voluntary suspension for another year, would not be adverse to the public interest and concludes that it should be authorized. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:




1. Ordering Paragraph No. 6 of Decision No. 79549, supra, is amended to read:

"6. The authority to suspend operation granted herein shall expire on December 6, 1973, or upon earlier resumption of operation which may be effected upon compliance with Ordering Paragraphs 3, 4, and 5." in place and stead of present Ordering Paragraph No. 6.

2. In all other respects the provisions of Decision No. 79549 remain in full force and effect.
