ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 80378 dated August 15, 1972, Virgil H. Monnet and Geneva C. Monnet, doing business as Manufacturers Distribution Terminal, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a public utility warehouseman in 25,000 square feet of space in the city of Emeryville. Because of certain difficulties that have arisen it requested that the time within which to commence operations be extended.
