(AIOO), requests the Comission to dixect its Transportation Division staff to complete and present the cost and rate studies contemplated in connection with Part 2 of Ordex Setting Hearing 213 In Case No. 5437, relating to statewide rates and rules for transportation by a carrier who provides a driver and power unit of equipment without trailing equipment.

In separate orders in Case No. 54.37 issued today, Part 2 of Order Setting Hearing 213 was discontinued and a new Order Setting Hearing was issued for the puxpose of receiving evidence concerming proposed additional rules in Minfmum Rate Tariffs 7 and 17-A providing for compensation to carriers which furnish units of equipment consisting of a tractor and driver without trailing equipment for the movement of comodities covered by the tariffs. The Comission staff is prepared to present rate and cost studies in the latter proceeding.
