ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 80737





Decision No. 80737, issued November 21, 1972, granted rehearing of Decision No. 80478, said rehearing being limited to oral argument on petitioner's (Harbor Carriers, Inc.) request to extend its existing scheduled service between Long Beach and Avalon to include other points on Santa Catalina Island. Petitioner now seeks modification and expansion of Decision No. 80737 to include oral argument on Conclusion No. 4 in Decision No. 80478.

Having considered each and every allegation in petitioner's request for modification of Decision No. 80737 and being of the opinion that good cause has been made to appear, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 80737 is modified to include in the rehearing of Decision No. 80478 oral argument on the legal interpretation of Public Utilities Code, Section 1007. Said rehearing shall be heard before Examiner Haley at 10:00 o'clock a.m. on January 26, 1973 in Los Angeles, California.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice of this modification of rehearing to be mailed immediately.
