SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 80973, issued today in Case No. 5432, et al.,
the Commission found that certain informational provisions in various minimum
rate tariffs had served their purpose and should be canceled. These provisions
pertain to the interstate transportation of property which is exempt from
regulation of the Interstate Commerce Commission under Sections 203(b)(6) and
203(b)(8) of the Interstate Commerce Act. The decision also provided that
Minimum Rate Tariffs 13 and 18 should be amended by separate order to permit
economical tariff distribution.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariffs 13 and 18 (Appendices B and B of Decisions
Nos. 55584 and 72418, respectively, as amended), are further amended by incorpor-
ating:




Fifth Revised Page 6 in Minimum Rate Tariff 13 and

2. In all other respects, Decisions Nos. 55584 and 72418, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
