ORDER OF DISCONTINUANCE

Industrial Communications Systems, Inc., on August 30, 1972, under Advice Letter No. 32, filed certain tariff sheets providing for the furnishing of radiotelephone service in major portions of San Diego County.

Imperial Communications Corporation by letter dated August 31, 1972 protested the tariff sheets filed by defendant under cover of its Advice Letter No. 22. Thereafter, the Commission issued an order of suspension and investigation of said tariff sheets which was docketed as Case No. 9443 and the tariff sheets were suspended to and including January 29, 1973.

A prehearing conference was held before Examiner Gillanders in San Francisco on January 22, 1973 after resetting from January 9, 1973.

After discussion re Case No. 9443 and its effect on Case No. 9476 - Industrial Communications Systems, Inc. v Imperial Communications Corporation - Industrial verbally agreed

to withdraw its Advice Letter No. 32 and Case No. 9476. Staff and protestant had no objection to this procedure.

Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the investigation in Case No. 9443 is discontinued and the tariff sheets filed under Advice Letter No. 32 are permanently suspended.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
