ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 74900 dated November 6, 1968, in Application No. 50437, Alfred H. Crooks, doing business as Dachshound Charter Lines, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the Cities of Concord and Fremont on the one hand and Naval Supply Center in Oakland on the other hand, and between Walnut Creek and the Mare Island Naval Shipyard in Vallejo and intermediate points.

Since March 2, 1970, Alfred H. Crooks, doing business as Dachshound Charter Lines, has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order 101-C.

The carrier has discontinued service and ceased operations.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized by Decision No. 74900 in Application No. 50437 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Alfred H. Crooks, dba Dachshound Charter Lines, are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this order to Alfred H. Crooks, Dachshound Charter Lines at 289 West "I" Street, P.O. Box 298, Benicia, CA 94510, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 30th day after the above mailing to Mr. Alfred H. Crooks at last known address, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
