ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 45291 dated January 23, 1951, in Application No. 31927, James W. Wootten dba Charter Transit Company was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Stockton and Venice Island Ferry and intermediate points and between Stockton and Bacon Island Ferry and intermediate points.

During 1960, James W. Wootten abandoned service and ceased operations according to a letter of August 3, 1972 from Francis X. Vierira, attorney for the carrier.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized by Decision No. 45291 in Application No. 31927 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of James W. Wootten dba Charter Transit Company are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be the 30th day after the above mailing to Mr. James W. Wootten, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
