## SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Raymond E. Polsley, an individual doing business as Polsley Transportation Service, is a highway common carrier of general commodities.

The authority was acquired pursuant to Decision No. 65371, dated May 14, 1963, in Application No. 45267 and amended by Decisions Nos. 68532, dated January 22, 1965, 68954, dated April 27, 1965 and 69748, dated October 5, 1965, all in Application No. 46498.

Service is restricted to traffic interlined with Northwestern Pacific Railroad, Pacific Motor Trucking Company and Pacific Motor Transport and interlined with said carriers at Willits.

Raymond E. Polsley has requested that his operating authority be temporarily suspended, as he is reorganizing his business.

After consideration, the Commission finds that the proposed suspension of service would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

Raymond E. Polsley, is placed on notice that commencement of operations under the certificate referred to in Ordering Paragraph 1 herein, prior to compliance with Ordering Paragraphs 3, 4 and 5, may be cause for further suspension or revocation of his operating authority.
