ORDER

The California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of State Route 5 over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, at the Location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit "B") attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. AU-96.8-A.

Authority is also granted to relocate a private at grade crossing substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit "C") attached to the application, in connection with the foregoing construction from Milepost No. 96.78 to Milepost No. 96.84. Protection shall be two private railroad grade crossing signs as depicted in Appendix A of Decision No. 75094.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto, and a copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by the Southern Pacific Transportation Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction.

Clearances shall be in accordance with General Order No. 26-D, and walkway areas adjacent to the railroad tracks shall be maintained free of obstructions and shall promptly be restored to their original condition in the event of damage during construction.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless the time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
