## OPINION

Morley Truck Iines, Inc. (Moriey) requests auchority to deviate from the provisions of Item 250 of Mnimum Rate Tariff 2.

Public hearing on the appifation was held before Examiner O ${ }^{\text {ILeary }}$ at San Francisco on December 11, 1972.

Applicant requests the deviation for two nccounts, Pervo Paint Co. (Pervo) and J. O. Ernst Irucking. At the hearing applicant requested that the application be amended so as to delete J. O. Erast Trucking.

The vice-president of appifcant testified that Pervo requested that Morley apply for the deviation so as to allow Pervo to pay its freight bills on the tenth of each month. The witness also testifled that the only reason Pervo made the request was because of convenience. A letter addressed to Morley from Pervo requesting the deviation was received as Exhibit I. No reasons for the request are set forth in Exhibit 1.
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The appifeation was protested by the California Irucking Assoclation.

The Comission finds that the convenience of Pervo Paint Co. is the sole reason advanced for requesting the deviation.

The Comission concludes that the application should be denied.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 53554 is denied.
