O P I N I O N

Morley Truck Lines, Inc. (Morley) requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Item 250 of Minimum Rate Tariff 2.

Public hearing on the application was held before Examiner O'Leary at San Francisco on December 11, 1972.

Applicant requests the deviation for two accounts, Pervo Paint Co. (Pervo) and J. O. Ernst Trucking. At the hearing applicant requested that the application be amended so as to delete J. O. Ernst Trucking.

The vice-president of applicant testified that Pervo requested that Morley apply for the deviation so as to allow Pervo to pay its freight bills on the tenth of each month. The witness also testified that the only reason Pervo made the request was because of convenience. A letter addressed to Morley from Pervo requesting the deviation was received as Exhibit 1. No reasons for the request are set forth in Exhibit 1.

The application was protested by the California Trucking Association.

The Commission finds that the convenience of Pervo Paint Co. is the sole reason advanced for requesting the deviation.

The Commission concludes that the application should be denied.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 53554 is denied.
