O R D E R

Crestview Limousine Service, Inc., a corporation, requests a permit to operate as a charter-party carrier of passengers, pursuant to Sections 5351-5419 of the Public Utilities Code.

A report by the Franchise Tax Board, Sacramento, California, shows that applicant was incorporated October 23, 1970, suspended September 15, 1971, and revived December 11, 1972.

A Commission staff representative reviewed the application and recommends that a permit issue, and for administrative convenience recommends that the permit issue under applicant's previous File No. TCP-247.

IT IS ORDERED that a permit be issued under File No. TCP-247 to Crestview Limousine Service, Inc. to operate as a charter-

party carrier of passengers, limited to a 50-mile radius of its home terminal, pursuant to Section 5384 of the Public Utilities Code.

The permit is to be issued and effective on the date of this order.
