ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 80602 dated October 11, 1972 in Application No. 53567, Bulk Transportation was granted interim authority, pending public hearing, to charge less than the otherwise governing minimum rates for the transportation of flue dust from Fontana to Cushenbury. The interim authority is scheduled to expire as of April 11, 1973.

Applicant advises that, due to technical difficulties, transportation under the temporary authority was delayed until January 22, 1973. Applicant now requests that its interim authority be extended pending public hearing of its application and issuance of the Commission's further order relative thereto.

It is apparent that Application No. 53567 cannot now be set for public hearing so as to afford the Commission sufficient time to consider the matter and issue its further order thereon prior to the April 4, 1973 expiration date of Decision No. 80602. The temporary authority granted by this decision should, therefore, be extended to August 26, 1973. A. 53567 af

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which Bulk Transportation may exercise the temporary authority granted by Decision No. 80602 is hereby extended to August 26, 1973.

In all other respects, Decision No. 80602 shall remain in full force and effect.
