O R D E R

The City of Vacaville is hereby authorized to construct Alonzo Road at grade across a track of the Sacramento Northern Railway in the City of Vacaville, in the County of Solano at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibits A, B and C) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 8G-3.6.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 30 feet and grades of approach not greater than six percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of General Order No. 72-A.

Clearances, including any curbs, shall conform to General Order 26-D. Walkways shall conform to General Order 118 in that the transition slope between walkways required under General Order 118 and top of roadway shall provide a reasonable regular surface with gradual slope not to exceed 1" vertical to 8" horizontal in all directions of approach.

Protection shall be two Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-C).

The new crossing shall not be opened to public use until the protection ordered herein is installed and operative.

Construction expense of the crossing and installation cost of automatic protection shall be borne by the applicant.

Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by the applicant. Sacramento Northern Railway shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Maintenance costs of the automatic protection shall be borne by the applicant pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless the time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
