ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 79480 dated December 14, 1971, in Application No. 52979, Peninsula Transit Lines, Inc. was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between and within the Cities of Palo Alto and Menlo Park and various surrounding areas.

Peninsula Transit Lines, Inc. has informed the Commission in writing that it has discontinued service because its assets were sold to the County of Santa Clara (Santa Clara County Transit District), on December 31, 1972. Public timetables now in effect show the assumption of such service by the county.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforenamed certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized by Decision No. 79480 in Application No. 52979 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Peninsula Transit Lines, Inc. are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this order to Peninsula Transit Lines, Inc. at 1841 Bay Road, Palo Alto, CA 94303, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 30th day after the above mailing to Peninsula Transit Lines, Inc., unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
